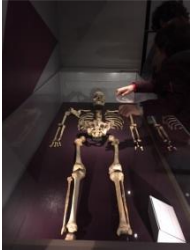
After school clubs

On Monday 3rd December Year 6 Riley and Hockney went to the Natural History Museum to reinforce their knowledge of 'Evolution and Inheritance' in Science. They had a chance to examine some fossils searching for evidence of change over time whilst explaining why these changes occur. Through role play, they had a chance to discuss Charles Darwin's theory of natural selection which highlights the idea that when change occurs, those organisms best suited to their new circumstances will thrive.
