We had 3 teams taking part in a very tough competition with many teams of a high standard.

The Black team were in an extremely tough group, and lost three very competitive matches against St Mary's Isleworth A (0-1), St Mary's Chiswick A (0-1) and St Lawrence RC A (0-3). The White team won their first game against St Mary's Isleworth C (2-0), then lost to St Mary's Chiswick B (0-2) and won their final game against Southville B (1-0), unfortunately they just missed out on qualifying for the quarter finals. In the final, we came up against St Mary's Chiswick C, this was most definitely the most competitive game of the tournament and unfortunately, despite a courageous effort right up the final whistle, we lost 1-0.
