### Table Tennis

William Hogarth Primary School in Chiswick became the venue for the ESTTA West London Table Tennis Under 11's qualification event, and what an event it turned out to be. Twenty children, who have only been playing for little more than a term, battled it out for places in the All London Jack Petchey Finals to be held at the University of East London in June.

In the girl's event, eight William Hogarth players were split into two groups of four and the battle commenced. Coming out on top in Group A were Darcey and Olwen, whilst in Group B Quynh and Evelyn proved the strongest players on the day. These four girls, who will now all qualify for the London Finals, then formed a new group of four, where they continued to fight it out for top honours. In this fiercely contested group, it was Darcey who again stormed to the top spot, dropping just a single game on her journey to the gold medal. In second place came Olwen. Congratulations to all eight girls who performed in both a highly competitive and sporting-like atmosphere.

It was a similar competitive affair in the boy's event where twelve of the best William Hogarth boys fought it out for two hours in a friendly but determined tournament. John and Aungkrit topped Group A, whilst Rio and Sam proved the strongest players in Group B. Having duly qualified for the All-London Finals, the four boys then went into a semi-final situation; Rio against Aungkrit and John against Sam. In two thrilling matches, Aungkrit and Sam emerged victorious and all that remained was for the two lads to battle it out for gold and silver. It proved to be a match worthy of a final, and by the closest of margins, Aungkrit got his hands on the gold medal and Sam had to settle for silver.

A great performance by all twenty players who now seem fully motivated for the coming tournaments in the second half of the season.
