# Cycle Club

**Safety Zone:** An opportunity to safety check bikes and clothing, including the 'M' Check to identify the elements and components of a bike for safety and smooth operation. To highlight elements of clothing that can help with cycling safely and that may cause a hazard. Parents are welcome to attend.

**Group Riding:** Trainees will be given training on how to cycle safely, within a group using the 'Snaking and double up' technique.

**Cycle Skills:** A combination of cycling activities through cycling games, to help the trainees gain some further skills and experience of riding and bike control. To include, Bikeability Level 1 outcomes in readiness for the Bikeability Level 2, on-road training.

**Bikeability Level 2:** Formal on-road safer cycle training, working towards the Bikeability Level 2 Award. Covering cycling on quiet roads with low traffic levels.

**Maintenance:** Basic bike repair tuition, how to fix punctures, adjust brakes, saddle and handlebar/control safety.

**Team Skills:** Safe 'team' cycling activities to include Highway Code, Route Planning and Team games like, James Bond, King of the Ring, Mind the Gap. Building on bike control skills before going on Lead Rides.

**Lead Ride:** A combination of lead rides to local areas. Depending on Centre location, ride destinations could include, Minet Park Cycle Circuit used by 'Slip Streamers' Cycle Club, Lake Farm BMX Track used by 'Hayes Hawks' BMX Club, Chiswick House, Osterley Park or Barnes. Trainees will be given the opportunity to lead the ride, with the lead instructor behind them and the rest of the group following in the 'Snake', with an instructor at the rear.
