As previously explained we are at the moment having work done to replace all our windows - a piece of work which was urgently needed. Much of this work was completed during the summer holidays but it was not possible to complete it all.

During the next two weeks the windows in Year 3/4 block will be replaced, and the Year 3 and 4 classes will be taught in different parts of the school. A letter is being sent today to the parents of the children in those classes to explain the arrangements.

In the meantime however we will need to ask for support from parents of children in other classes to ensure everything runs smoothly.

There will be no access to any part of the school through the school hall - classes will be taking place there from 9am to 3.30 every day. They must not be disrupted by parents or visitors walking through. Please respect the children and teachers of year 4 by walking round the building if you need to access the back playground or upper school block.

Year 3 children will need to be dismissed through the main entrance of the school. Please keep this area clear at the end of the day so that year 3 teachers can see parents easily and hand children over safely.
