Black tracksuit with hoodie school logo

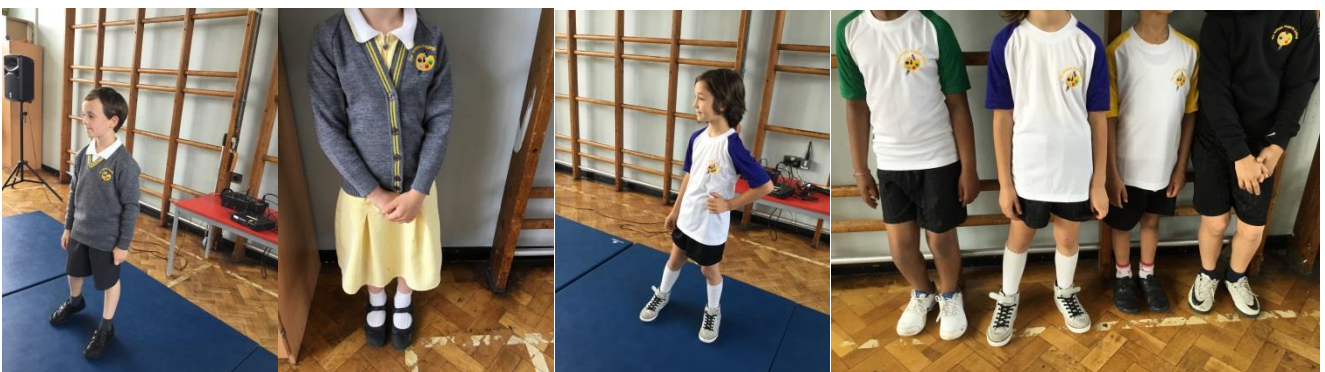
Trainers / black plimsolls
