Please can we remind parents that they **must supervise** their child/ren at all times. **Nobody** should enter the building unless picking up from an after school club. The school is closed at the end of the school day except for the playground which is open until 4.50p.m. There will be no access to the toilets if you are staying in the playground at the end of the day in order to ensure the school remains secure.

Scooter/bikes

We are really pleased to see so many children cycling to school but can we remind adults and children that they should not cycle/ride on the school playground – this is dangerous for pedestrians.

School Building

When bringing your child/ren to school please bring them to their line in the playground, parents/carers should **NOT** enter the school building unless they have an appointment or need to see the office staff. If your child is late you need to bring them to the late desk where we will order them a lunch and ensure they get to class.

If you use Breakfast Club, please can we ask you to use the entrance on Devonshire Street. There is a bell that you will need to ring and a member of staff will open the door for you. Breakfast Club starts at 8.00am
