# FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Did you know every child in reception and years 1 & 2  
**can get a free meal at lunchtime?**

If you haven't already applied, all you need to do  
is fill in a simple application form



When your child is in year 3 or above, they might still get free school meals if you are receiving:

- income support
- income-based jobseekers allowance
- income related employment and support allowance
- the guaranteed element of state pension credit
- child Tax Credit
- support from the National Asylum Support Service

If you are eligible, the school will also get a 'pupil premium' for your child.  
This is extra funding for the school to spend on their development.
