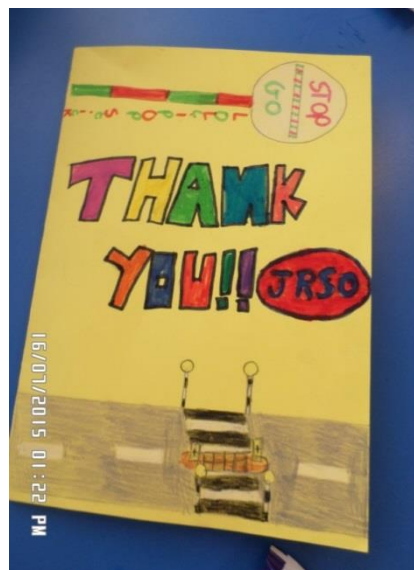

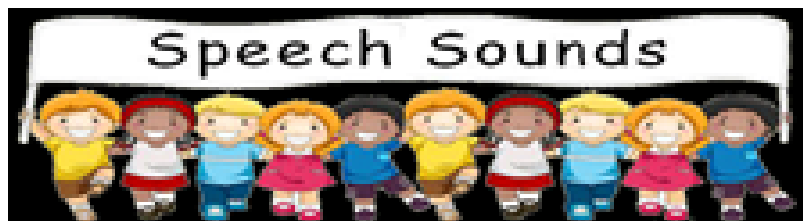
Cake sale:
