Guinness World Record success

Back in June, 10 Year 4 pupils (now Year 5) took part at a Tennis competition at Dukes Meadows Tennis Club.

As part of this day, they were joined by children from all across Hounslow Borough to break the Guinness World Record for the World's Largest Tennis Lesson. The record (405 participants) was set by Judy Murray in The USA in April and on the same day as the competition it was broken by another group in Liverpool (650 participants).

However, we can confirm that they successfully achieved a new GUINNESS WORLD RECORD for 'The world's largest tennis lesson' at the competition with 770 participants involved.

Well done to the ten children from the school that took part: Mehrez, Amelia, Esmee, Harvey, Julia F, Hashem, Lauren, Olivia, Hussein and Luc. This is the second tennis Guinness World Record achieved by the pupils of Hounslow in two years.

Assertiveness for your child



Sometimes we say 'assertive' when we mean bossy - we make it a negative term.

True assertiveness is most certainly not bossy, it is polite, clear and non blaming - speech and behaviour that is neither aggressive nor passive.

This workshop will help parents help their child who is either too pushy or aggressive at times, possibly without even realising it, or so quiet and timid they get picked on by others or feel left out and marginalised.
